Early Childhood Services

Child Care

Child Care Resource & Referral

Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) provides resources, education and advocacy to support quality child care. They assist families in finding care that meets their needs and talk to parents about quality indicators such as ChildNet and the lowa Quality Rating System (QRS). Child Care Consultants provide on-site consultation to all preschools, centers, homes and before and after school programs. CCR&R also provides professional development to child care professionals and provides data to community leaders.

Non-registered home providers can care for five or fewer children at one time (including their own) and are not required to be registered. They are mostly unregulated.

Registered Home providers may care for six or more children at one time and agree to meet minimum health and safety standards. There are three categories of registration, based on size of house, education level and years of experience.

Child Care Centers and Preschools are either licensed by the lowa Department of Human Services, or regulated by the lowa Department of Education (if in a school building). These programs must be in compliance with standards set forth by their respective departments.
