### CHILD CARE RESOURCE & REFERRAL

Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) provides resources, education and advocacy to support quality child care. They assist families in finding care that meets their needs and talk to parents about quality indicators such as ChildNet and the Iowa Quality Rating System (QRS). Child Care Consultants provide on-site consultation to all preschools, centers, homes and before and after school programs. CCR&R also provides professional development to child care professionals and provides data to community leaders.

Child Care Home providers care for five or fewer children at one time (including their own) and are not registered. CCR&R can refer them if the provider passes an Iowa Abuse Registry Check. They are mostly unregulated and only visited if Department of Human Services (DHS) receives a complaint.

Child Care Homes Approved to Accept Child Care Assistance payments can care for five or fewer children at one time (including their own). They are not registered. Providers have to take twelve hours of health and safety training and pass record checks. DHS visits them once a year.

Child Development Home providers are registered. They may care for six or more children at one time. They agree to meet minimum health and safety standards and pass record checks. DHS visits them once a year.

The Iowa Department of Human Services licenses child care centers and some preschools. Centers and preschools must comply with standards set forth by their respective departments.
