Changes in FY26

The Partnerships 4 Families Early Childhood Iowa area that serves Audubon, Carroll, Greene and Guthrie Counties will see some changes in FY26 due to directives from the Early Intervention and Support Bureau at Iowa Health and Human Services. ECI areas are no longer eligible to support programs that provide consultation or nursing services to child care environments. Those services are to be provided exclusively by CCR&R. Due to this change, a long standing program that P4F has supported for over 25 years will no longer be eligible for funds. It is with verv sad news we announce that the Child Care Project will no longer be available to programs in our area. The support that Trisha Christensen has provided for 25 years will be greatly missed.

Providers will continue to see the CCNC available in our area but funding for that shifted and will now be provided 100% by HHS.

P4F will continue to support the HOPES program in all four of our counties. They will be working to align with a national family support model in FY26. Stay tuned for that change.

Early Childhood Continuum of Care Grant Opportunity

Although the Iowa Legislature did not pass the bill that contained the Early Childhood Continuum of Care grant Iowa HHS and DE are moving forward with the grant.

The goal of the grant is to allow school districts and licensed child care centers to work together to offer a full day of care to children attending preschool. Information can be found at the following website.

Sun Safety

As the clouds of spring start to move out it is time to get out the sunscreen and protect the winter white checks of the little ones in your life.

The AAP recommends keeping babies under the age of 6 months out of direct sunlight due to the damaging rays of the sun.

When choosing sunscreen they recommend an SPF of at least a 15 and to reapply every two hours or after swimming.

Even if there are some clouds the sun does shine through, so use the sunscreen on cloudy days too.

Risk Factors

Risk factors in child development encompass a wide range of factors that can negatively impact a child's physical, emotional, social, and cognitive growth. These factors can be broadly categorized into biological, environmental, and familial influences. Examples include poverty, maternal depression, substance abuse during pregnancy, exposure to violence or neglect, and poor nutrition.
