

Reach Out and Read lowa prepares America's youngest children to succeed in school by partnering with doctors to prescribe books and encourage families to read together.

Children receiving care at participating clinics will be "prescribed" a book to read with their family and given information about the importance of reading daily. Some clinics provide a book at each well child checkup, but participation can vary.
