Early Childhood Iowa has released the FY22ECI State Annual Report. If you have never taken the time to glance at the report I encourage you to do so. There is information about the historical funding of ECI, performance measure data and a highlight of projects that might of have taken place this year across the happy to meet with you and discuss state.

It is very impressive to see how many children are served through family support programs. It was 6,384 if you were wondering, but check out the annual report to show who is being served. Or did you know that across the state 20 ECI area boards expended \$680,414 and served 14,866 children who
