

The P4F Board did not meet in March but will be meeting in April and will discuss how our area will approach the possible reduction in funding for FY24. Draft allocation figures have been released and the P4F area could possibly lose \$3,368 of EC funding and \$11,940 of SR funding. This lose is due to changing population and

income trends across the state. As of this newsletter there is no expected new funding for FY24 to ECI Areas.

The next meeting of the P4F Board is on Thursday April 20, 2023 at 11:00. The meeting will be held in person at New Opportunities with a Zoom option.
