

P4F Funding had Small Increase

For the first time in 10 year P4F will have a small increase in funding for FY20. The increases were received in both our School Ready funding and our Early Childhood funding. The School Ready funding received an increase due to the State Legislators providing a \$500,000 increase in allocation to our School Ready General category. After disbursing that across the state P4F has an increase of \$20,000. Having these funds allowed the P4F Board to fund a new program to our area of the Child Care Nurse Consultant through New Opportunities Maternal Child Health Program.

Our Early Childhood funding saw an increase due to the formula change put in place two years ago. This year we had an additional \$5000 which assisted in the funding of the Child Care Project.

Early Childhood Information at Libraries

A few years ago P4F did an outreach project with the area libraries where we purchased brochure holders for early childhood or family information. Many of the libraries in our area still use them. This summer we will be updating those brochure holders with the new early childhood brochures.
