

FY22 Programs funded by P4F

On May 20th the P4F Board met to discuss and allocate funding for FY22. This marks the 23rd funding cycle that the P4F Board has completed. They continue to focus a majority of the school ready funding on the HOPES program that provides home visitation to families. A focus will be on serving prenatal families or families with children 0-3. During FY22 the P4F Board will spend the year getting to know the program better, the staffing of it and the number of families being served.

Funding was also allocated to the Child Care Project that supports our licensed child care centers and preschools in our area. The Child Care Nurse Consultant, dental screenings at preschools, and preschool tuition assistance to three year olds at participating preschools. These projects, along with funding to support the activities of the board and the area director who networks with early childhood providers to build our early childhood system, are intended to assist in "Every child beginning at birth being healthy and successful."
