

UPDATE ON Collaborative Services Areas-CSA

 Every Child beginning at birth will be healthy and successful. Collaborative Service Areas (CSAs) are the title being given to areas that will provide services for WIC, MCAH, I-Smile, Family Planning and 1st Five. Iowa Department of Public Health-IDPH, now Health and Human Services-HHS. New Opportunities Health Department will be providing WIC Services to our CSA. HCCMS-Helping Communities Connect Multiple Services out of Crawford County Community Health will be providing the Child Health Services such as CCNC, i-Smile, Hawki

outreach and other services to our CSA area.

The CSA-2 will include Audubon, Buena Vista, Carroll, Crawford, Greene, Guthrie and Sac counties.

The number of grant awarded will be determined by the number received and the amounts requested. Grants are due November 8thand will be announced the end of November.
