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## Social Emotional Development of Children

Social emotional development of children is on many people's minds and P4F is going to spend some time and funding this year addressing the needs. On July 7<sup>th</sup> we will gather to discuss how as an Early Childhood Iowa area we can address the needs of children and early childhood providers.

### From Zero to Three: Social and Emotional Development

Strong, positive relationships help children develop trust, empathy, compassion and a sense of right and wrong.

Starting from birth, babies learn who they are by how they are treated. Loving relationships provide young children with a sense of comfort, safety and confidence. They teach young children how to form friendships, communicate emotions and deal with challenges.

## P4F Has Available ASQ:SE-2

Are you familiar with the Ages and Stages Questionnaires? Did you know that they have been around for 40 years?

The ASQ's are screening tools that allow parents an active role in determining the development level of their child. The tool is to be filled out by the parent then scored to determine if the child is progressing according to developmental standards for

their age. Together the parent and early childhood professional or medical staff can suggest resources for follow-up, monitoring or further assessment if needed.

The ASQ has developed over the years and we now have the ASQ-3 and the ASQ:SE-2, which focuses on the social emotional development of the child.
