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Preschool and Head Start Recuritment

The start of next year's school year may seem a long way away, but for preschools and Head Start sites they are thinking ahead and hope that families of children 3 and 4 are also planning ahead.

Each school district manages recruitment for preschool differently. Some have a survey indicating interests, some do developmental screenings and others have an open house.

Head Start does outreach directly to families to determine eligibility. No matter the avenue the goal is to gain information about the number of children that will be enrolling in the fall. Classrooms have a certain number of students that can be served and early enrollment allows the school district and Head and register with their Start to know how many classrooms they will need and how many teachers.

All the school districts and Head Start family advocates ask that if you are working with families to encourage them to contact the school district office in their area to ask about registration or to watch the school districts website. Even if a family thinks they may be moving before fall they should go ahead local school or Head Start.
